Dear Medbourne Parish Council,

Thank you for your recent enquiry concerning the current speed limits in Uppingham Road and Hallaton Road, Medbourne.

While we take every traffic safety request received seriously, unfortunately due to the volume of enquiries, of which we receive over 3000 a year, our limited resources, and in order to investigate enquires fully, we will not be able to respond to you immediately.

In order to investigate fully, we need to gather traffic data, including recent traffic speeds, traffic volumes, and the past five year's accident history to better assess your request.

We should therefore be in a position to respond to your query within four to six weeks, however if the investigation is going to take longer we will advise you of this.

Please note that while we will undertake an initial investigation into your request, there is no guarantee that a scheme on the highway will result. We would assure you however, that if the investigation concludes action is warranted, we will do what we can to ensure this is included in a future works programme.

We understand this does not offer an immediate solution to your request, but hope that you can appreciate the need for appropriate investigation, the significant volume of such requests and the necessity to carry out this work in a cost effective way.

We will contact you within four to six weeks to inform you of the conclusion of the investigation into your request.
