Medbourne Neighbourhood Development Plan - Final Decision Statement Notice

Following a positive referendum result Harborough District Council is publishing its decision to 'make' the Medbourne Neighbourhood Development Plan part of Harborough District Councils Development Plan in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

The referendum held on 28th June 2018 met the requirements of the Localism Act 2011; it was held in the Parish of Medbourne and posed the question: 'Do you want Harborough District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Medbourne to help it decide planning applications in the Neighbourhood area?'

The count took place on 28th June 2018 and greater than 50% of those who voted were in favour of the Plan being used to help decide planning applications in the plan area. The results of the referendum were:
